

## PROGRAMME

Center for Excellence in Music and Applications (CEMA), a unit of IARSc, offers Post Graduate Diploma by research in Indian Classical Vocal and Instrumental Music, and Musicology. This course introduces and trains candidates on research techniques applicable to music analysis. The techniques could be practical, theoretical, mathematical, computing, statistical or lab-based.

This Diploma is a bridge course preparing the candidates for Ph.D programme in Music and Musicology. The programme duration is one year.

# POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN MUSIC AND MUSICOLOGY



## PRE-REQUIRE

Bachelor/Master in Science, Engineering, Statistics, Arts, Commerce or any discipline with 55% aggregate marks. In addition to this basic qualification in education, the candidates are required to be qualified in Karnataka State Education Board Senior grade examination in music/instrumental or Bachelor/Master in Music/Musicology or any equivalent course. This course is open for all age group.

## SCHEDULE

The candidates need to register for the course by writing to Director IARSc (kusuma@iarsc.in). Followed by registration, the candidates are required to appear for an interview before an expert committee. Selection is based on candidate's performance in the interview. Upon successful completion of the course, students will be awarded a Certificate in Post Graduate Diploma from IARSc.
